*Have pheromones peaked your curiosity and you're willing to test them away, but they are confused and skeptical within the overpowering number of companies and websites selling pheromones and the wild claims they will make?*

Have been using pheromones for several years and while I've never seen the wild results that some of these products promise, I have had some pretty good results with some products and possess seen solid and simpler results.

There are hundreds, if not thousands of websites selling products, offering product reviews and also links to suppliers. I can tell you from first hand experience and from information shared by others that the vast majority of these companies, websites and reviews are scams. If you find a [pheromone review](#) website that gives a 5 legend rating to a product and offers a link to their website, hover your mouse over the link and search in the standing bar in the bottom of the browser, if the link doesn't go directly to the particular companies website it is almost certainly linking through an affiliate marketing and advertising program, and the owner of the pheromone review site is paid a commission for every customer they refer.

*You don't see the status bar at the bottom of your screen, you can enable it in Internet Explorer or FireFox by clicking on the "View" menu at the very top of your browser and checking next to the Status Bar.*

- So, how can you discover legitimate products that will work and allow you to achieve your desired goals?
- Your best bet is to join a couple of forums, ask questions and read what others have to say.
- And once again there are a number of forums and most of them are owned by pheromone companies.
- Some of these forums are very energetic, while others tend to be nearly dormant.
- Some let you talk about any pheromone product, while others will only let you talk about products they sell.
- Some will let you talk about a couple of other companies or products, while blacklisting others.
- And some forums heavily censor member postings, while others may not.
- So, right now we have to look for a genuine forum!
- Among the best ways to calculate the actual credibility of a pheromone forum is as simple as taking a look at their members:

*Do they have an active membership, or are the vast majority of postings coming from one or two people?*

*And just as importantly, carry out the administrators seem helpful and informative, or even perform they seem negative and judgmental?*

Once again, I can tell you from experience that some of the largest and most active forums on the net have become nothing more than marketing tools and hoopla to sell their own products and they are not truly interested in providing accurate and helpful information to people seeking information on products other than their own.

By now your head is probably spinning and you're about ready to give up, right? Don't! Pheromones do work and there are genuine goods out there. You just have to look around a bit, do your research, and find the right companies and products to buy. They're out there, and pheromones do work!

There are only a couple of forums on the net that are not affiliated with any company or product. These forums aren't large in size and do not have thousands of people that were bought through marketing efforts, but exist solely for pheromone enthusiasts to talk with each other and share information.
